Level up your commute with the Transit app-OmniRide's official app! OmniRide has upgraded you to the Royale subscription in the Transit app at no cost. The Transit app is a public transit navigation app that you can use to plan trips on OmniRide's bus services. The app shows nearby departure times and has a step-by-step navigation mode to help keep your commute on track. And it works in 1000 other cities all around the world!

Royale unlocks special features and customization options in Transit, such as...

- Improved real-time bus information
- Additional trip-planning options
- "Rate-My-Ride" to gather feedback
- Special app themes and icons

Transit automatically determines if you're a rider of our agency's services and applies the Royale upgrade without you having to do anything! If you haven't been granted a free Royale upgrade, you can contact Transit directly within the app to ask for it. Users who have not upgraded to Royale will not have access to the additional app features. Travel Training Builds Transit Confidence in Manassas Community

OmniRide hosted the first-ever all-Spanish-language travel training in the Georgetown South community of Manassas. The neighborhood is served by OmniRide's local bus routes 65 (Manassas North), 67 (Manassas South), and 96 (East-West Express), making it an ideal location to connect residents with our transit resources.

The training welcomed 25 in-person participants and was divided into two parts. During the classroom session, attendees reviewed local bus routes, learned how to determine which routes to use and where they go, and received guided support on how to use OmniRide's official app, Transit. The second portion included a bus tour covering bus etiquette and a live demonstration of how to load a bike onto the bus. Participants were encouraged to ask questions throughout, and one attendee even hosted a Facebook Live to share the information with community members who could not attend.

The session also highlighted that local bus service is fare-free through June 2026 and shared information about our Metro Express buses, which can help riders access additional job opportunities across the region.

Upcoming Trainings

Additional travel trainings are planned for the spring of 2026, including a ride-along experience where participants will ride the bus with staff, ask questions in real time, and build confidence using transit. A second classroom training will also be offered for teenagers to help them prepare for commuting to jobs, internships, or local NOVA campuses. Interested in scheduling a travel training session? 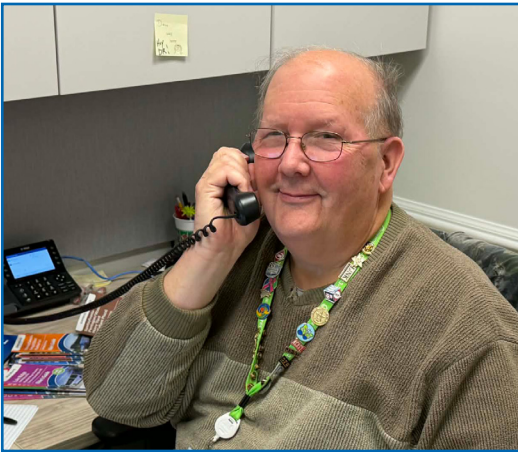
