





INSTRUCTIONS

The route always runs from left to right.
The map and timetable also read from left to right.

The bus stops here at listed times.
Look for the matching symbol below the map.

The bus travels here sometimes.
See schedule for trips that travel this route variation.



T Transfer Center is a location where many transfer options are available between OmniRide buses or other regional transit services. Transfers are also possible at other locations where routes intersect.

1 The bus stops at each of the times listed below the symbol.

The timetable shows WHEN the bus stops. Times are always approximate and depend upon traffic and weather conditions.

FARE-FREE through June 30, 2026**FARES**

OmniRide Local buses will operate FARE-FREE through June 30, 2026.

Riders transferring to OmniRide Express buses will be required to pay the Express fare.

TRANSFER OPTIONS

Riders transferring to OmniRide Express buses will be required to pay the Express fare using a SmarTrip card or SmarTrip mobile payment option upon boarding. All OmniRide Local, OmniRide Metro Express and OmniRide East-West Express buses are currently operating FARE-FREE, so no transfers are required.

Between OmniRide Buses and VRE Trains:

- VRE monthly pass holders—boarding an OmniRide bus at a VRE Station or the bus stop nearest a VRE Station ride FREE. When riding an OmniRide bus to get to a VRE Station, the applicable bus fare is required.
- ALL other VRE pass holders—are required to pay applicable bus fare when traveling to and from VRE Stations.

OTHER OMNIRIDE SERVICES

OmniRide Express buses originate from points throughout eastern Prince William County, the Manassas area, Gainesville/Haymarket, Front Royal, Warrenton and Stafford, and Spotsylvania Counties to destinations that include the Pentagon, Crystal City, Rosslyn/Ballston, Dulles Corridor, Herndon/Reston, Tysons Corner and Washington, D.C.

OmniRide Metro Express connects you with nearby Metrorail stations.

- The Prince William route connects eastern Prince William with the Franconia-Springfield Metro Station, with stops at the OmniRide Transit Center, Potomac Mills Mall and Route 1 in Woodbridge.
- The Manassas route operates between Manassas Mall and Tysons Corner Metro Station.

OmniRide Local buses serve nine routes in Prince William and the Manassas area. In Eastern Prince William County buses serve seven routes and two routes operate in the Manassas area.

OmniRide Connect is a microtransit service that operates in Dumfries, Quantico and Manassas Park. It is an on-demand, shared public transit transportation option that serves passengers using dynamically generated routes. Riders may request rides using an app or by calling Customer Service.

OmniRide Access is a paratransit service for people with disabilities. Vans operate within ¾ mile of all the OmniRide Local bus routes that serve Manassas and Manassas Park.

OmniRide Ridesharing offers a FREE ridematching service to assist commuters who prefer to carpool or vanpool to find the ride that best suits your commute needs. The program can also assist those wishing to start a carpool or vanpool.
